A quality entry of Prime Cattle forward with 44 going under the hammer to a stand-on trade. Topping the steers was a cracking 534kg Limousin from Mr J M Venning of St Stephen, St Austell which traded at 289p/kg away to Mr R H Eddy of Tehidy, with another Limousin steer hot on the heels at 285p/kg, this time from Messrs W T Bryant & Sons of St Martin, purchased by Mr A C Chudleigh of Lawhitton. Further steers from Mr Venning at 282p/kg and 279p/kg, with another Limousin from J B Old Farms Ltd of Treyarnon Bay featuring next at 273p/kg. A heavier weight Charolais steer from Messrs Bryant realised 269p/kg to Mr Chudleigh again, and J B Old Farms Ltd saw their Charolais away at 267p/kg. A pair of Simmental steers from Messrs E A & A R Thomas of Sevenmilestone followed suit at 260p/kg and 255p/kg both to Mr Eddy. Heifers were very well topped by a shapey Limousin from Messrs Bryant at 285p/kg bought by J V Richards Ltd of Perranwell Station and in reverse-steer-order Mr Venning took runner up with a heavier weight at 280p/kg and his lighter weights at 278p/kg and 276p/kg. Messrs Bryant were in the mix again with heifers at 277p/kg and 275p/kg. With such a busy week, many Vendors marketed high quality animals all well above 230p/kg which are too numerous to mention.

Another week of big numbers both in entry and prices, with all **260** of the entry looking very well sold. Top of the day was a trio of brilliant 18 month old Charolais steers from Messrs W F Palmer & Son of Ruan High Lanes which sold for £1675. Second spot was for four 23 month old Limousin steers at £1530 from a run of cattle from Mr V Gay of St Austell, with four more strong Charolais from Messrs Palmer next at £1490. Messrs R A & E A Wilkins of Truro saw their trio of Aberdeen Angus' at £1380 and a single Limousin steer from Mrs S E Thomas-Weir of St Martin reached £1370. A good run of cattle from Mr R T Dunn of Par, St Austell saw prices to £1340 and £1320 for bunches of Charolais', Simmental to £1125 and South Devon to £1080. A single 17 month old Continental steer from Mr L Mann of Falmouth realised £1280 and top of a quality run of cattle from Messrs C R, I E & A M White was next at £1275 for a single 15 month old Charolais. Heifers reached a top of £1500 for four 21 month old Limousins from Messrs White and a bunch of seven slightly younger Limousins from the same Vendor at £1365. 
