PRIME CATTLE

<u>Auctioneer</u> – Andrew Body

A sensational run of clean cattle at Truro this week, with very good numbers entered and the New Year trade as hot as ever. Top call was for the stand-out bullock from a run of high quality animals from F G Pryor & Son Ltd of Perranwell Station, who had a total of 53 head pass through both the prime and store rings combined. They topped the steers with their Limousin realising 284p/kg, with another steer at 272p/kg (£2004 per head) and also took top honours in the heifers at 270p/kg and 261p/kg. Next up in the steers was a cracking run of cattle from Messrs R E, G L & M R Body of Hayle with their top 711kg Charolais at 278p/kg, Limousins at 274p/kg twice and 265p/kg, British Blue to 267p/kg, Hereford to 246p/kg and South Devon to 236p/kg. Messrs Body also made the top pounds-per-head of £2033. Messrs T A & A M Wills of St Erme saw their Limousin steer realise 268p/kg away to Mr R H Eddy of Tehidy. Further heifers to 258p/kg on behalf of Messrs D L & A E Grigg of Truro, and an Angus heifer from Messrs E, M & S Beale of Porthtowan at 251p/kg to Harvey Brothers of St Just. A superb entry of 50 stores from F G Pryor & Son Ltd of Perranwell Station, Truro, saw a 22 month old pair of Limousin steers realise £1570, with 1 year old Limousins to £1185, Herefords to £1165 & £1110 and Charolais to £1070 thereafter. Mr J A Skewes of Penwartha, Perranporth saw his pair of Aberdeen Angus steers achieve £1490, whilst Mr M George of Penzance also sold a pair of Angus to £1270. Strong 16 month old British Blue steers to £1005 for Messrs J R Semmens & Son of St Levan, Penzance. Heifers to £1590, again cracking 2 year olds from F G Pryor & Son Ltd with further lots to £1580, £1525 and £1445.
