The strong January trade continues to hold firm, with the numbers of cattle forward not easing and the entry of **38** all looked very well sold. Another joint top price this week was shared between the best steer from a run of quality Limousins from Mr J M Venning of St Stephen and a good Limousin steer from Mrs J Julian of Summercourt, Newquay both sold for **286p/kg** right at the sharp end of the trade. Next up was a run of strong cattle in from Messrs R E, G L & M R Body of Hayle with their top Blonde steer trading at **284p/kg**, another at **280p/kg**, a Charolais steer at **267p/kg**, a Limousin steer at **260p/kg** and a Simmental steer at **259p/kg**. A pair of Limousin steers from Messrs W J P Julian of Summercourt, Newquay, were next to feature at **278p/kg** and **276p/kg**, the latter tied with another Limousin steer from Mr Venning at the same money. Mr Venning also claimed the top three spots in the heifers, with three more cracking Limousins at **280p/kg**, **279p/kg** and **278p/kg** looking well placed. A pair of South Devon heifers from Laity Farms of Hayle realised **261p/kg** and **255p/kg** respectively, and a Limousin heifer from Messrs W S Gay & Son of St Allen was close behind at **254p/kg**. Top pounds-per-head was awarded to Mr Venning with his **855kg** Limousin steer at **253p/kg** realising **£2,163**.
