A shorter entry than has been seen in recent weeks, with prices reflective of what was on offer. A good pair of Limousins from Messrs T A & A M Wills of St Erme, Truro claimed the top spots in both the heifer and steer sections, with their 605kg steer realising 268p/kg to Messrs K & D McFadden of St Just and their 595kg heifer reached 258p/kg away to R J Trevarthen Ltd of Roskrow. What a sensational entry of cattle through the store ring this week, with lofty prices seen throughout the whole entry. Star of the day was an absolutely topping run of forward steers from Mr T G Hawke of Colan, Newquay with his stand out top trio of South Devons realising £1750, a single South Devon very close behind at £1745, another trio at £1705 and more at £1660, £1600 and £1560 to name but a few. 10 heifers from the same Vendor entered for next week. Mr W R Beard of Penzance was very well in the mix with his run of high quality cattle to a very healthy £1670 for a single classy Angus steer, a trio of Blues at £1620 and more at £1600, £1580 and £1490. A single fleshy Blue steer from Messrs A J & K P Johns of Truro traded for £1370, followed by a pair of younger 15 month old Charolais' at £1275 on behalf of Messrs J & S Trembath of Gurnards Head. A run of good cattle from Mr W E Hosken of Manaccan topped at £1225 for a bunch of six 23 month old Blue steers and a single 22 month old Angus from Messrs J M, S K & J K Sawle of Gunwalloe went under the hammer for £1145. Heifers peaked at £1600 for a very well sold single 29 month old Limousin from Mr Beard, followed by a single 25 month old Blue heifer from Mr Hosken at £1395. A similar number to recent weeks, with a sharper trade this week, seeing plenty of buying power around the ring.
