FATS ON FIRE! A roaring trade seen this week at Truro, with numbers forward up again and prices across the board looking very healthy indeed. Two cracking bullocks shared the huge top price of 297p/kg, these being a quality Limousin steer from Mrs J Julian of Summercourt and a classy OTM Charolais steer from Messrs R E, G L & M R Body of Hayle. Another pair of Limousin steers from Mrs Julian were next in line at 295p/kg and 291p/kg, followed by a pair of Limousin steers from Messrs J J Tredinnick & Son of Perranporth, Newquay this time, which made 287p/kg and 281p/kg. A Charolais steer from Messrs D L & A E Grigg of Truro made 268p/kg, which was shared with the top Simmental steer of a trio of cattle forward from Messrs T B & M B Osborne of St Eval, Wadebridge. Heifers peaked at 279p/kg for a 620kg Charolais from Messrs Grigg, with a second Charolais heifer from the same Vendor at 265p/kg. A Limousin heifer from Messrs Osborne realised 261p/kg and an Angus heifer from Messrs A R, B & A Hosking of St Martin, Helston saw 260p/kg. STORE CATTLE - Auctioneer – Patrick Dennis

A stand-on entry of store cattle in both numbers through the ring and the strong prices achieved, although less forward types entered. A cracking pair of 25 month old British Blue x steers from Mr W F Palmer & Son of Ruan High Lanes raced away to top the stores at £1735 (12 Pure bred Charolais heifers entered for next week for the same Vendor) Good Angus steers from Mr J M Hinkley of Truro saw his top bunch of six 22 month-ers trade for £1465 and his second same-aged trio sitting pretty at £1240. Next up was Messrs D C Roberts & Son of Praze with the pick of their cattle at £1425 for five 20 month Hereford steers and three more at £1195. Messrs W H Pengelly & Son of Praze-an-Beeble saw their pair of 24 month Angus steers at £1290, with further prices at £1135, £1100 and £1080 to name a few. Topping the heifers was another brilliant entry of cattle from Mr T G Hawke of Colan, Newquay with prices at £1515, £1475, £1340 and £1310 for South Devons, £1380 for a single Hereford and £1150 for an Angus. Messrs Pengelly's heifers topped at £1240 and Messrs Roberts' pair of Herefords realised £1090. A large proportion of younger cattle this week all looked very well sold, with 10 month old Angus steers from Devichoys Farm Ltd of Perranarworthal to £1115. A run of classy young cattle from Messrs F G Gluyas & Partners of Camborne saw prices to £925 for a pair of 10 month old Limousin steers, and a run of shapey young suckled calves from Messrs A P & S R Hooper of Castle-an-Dinas peaked at £955 for a pair of Blue heifers and steers to £900 for a single 8 month old Limousin.
