The blistering Truro trade continues, with Prime Cattle to a new record breaking high of **304p/kg** for a stunning **571kg** butchers type Limousin heifer from Messrs W T Bryant & Sons of St Martin, Helston purchased by Harvey Brothers of St Just. Eight bullocks of the entry all traded at 290p/kg or above, with joint runners-up being a 691kg Limousin steer from Messrs Bryant at 299p/kg and a 651kg Limousin steer from Mrs J Julian of Summercourt, Newquay at the same money. Next up was a cracking 602kg Limousin steer from Messrs J & J Sawle & Son of St Agnes at 298p/kg. Only one bid behind at 297p/kg was another shared price between a high-quality Limousin steer from Messrs Sawle and a heavier-weight 698kg Limousin steer from Messrs Bryant. A strong Limousin from Mrs Julian went under the hammer for 291p/kg away to R J Trevarthen Ltd of Roskrow and Messrs Sawle then featured again with yet another classy Limousin at 290p/kg. Topping the OTM section was a huge **760kg** Limousin steer from Messrs Bryant which raced away to **287p/kg** and also claimed the top pounds-per-head of £2,181. Many more Premium bullocks all traded well above 260p/kg which are too numerous to mention, but are all a credit to their Vendors.
