The fierce trade is showing no let up and the whole entry looked very well sold again, with nine of the bullocks forward at **290p/kg** or above. Top honours were awarded to a brilliant **694kg** Limousin steer from Messrs W T Bryant and Sons of St Martin, Helston at **303p/kg** purchased by R J Trevarthen Ltd of Roskrow. Next up was a cracking run of cattle from Mrs J Julian of Summercourt with her top Limousin steer trading at **299p/kg** and a further two both at **295p/kg**, these were tied with a classy Limousin steer from Messrs J & J Sawle & Son of St Agnes at the same money. Messrs Bryant featured again with their Limousin steer at **292p/kg** and another Limousin from Messrs Sawle was close behind at **291p/kg**.
