Vet Attestation - Requirement for livestock entering the food chain which may be exported to the European Union (EU)

To Livestock Producers.

If you are not part of a qualifying assurance scheme and have not yet received a vet visit and Vet Attestation Number (VAN), very shortly your business will be impacted if your livestock or any part of animal products derived from your livestock enters the food chain and may be exported to the EU.

Exports to the European Union (EU) will be stopped for livestock, livestock products and some 5th quarter products, from livestock farmers who do not provide a Vet Attestation Number (VAN) or show that they are part of a qualifying farm assurance scheme. ACT NOW. If you do nothing and do not have a VAN, it may limit the value and demand for your livestock.

If you are not part of a qualifying assurance scheme and have not already received a vet visit and VAN, you should follow the steps below, or you may limit the value and demand for your livestock at a market or abattoir in the near future.

Speak to your vet to either;

a) **request a backdated vet attestation and VAN** from a farm visit in the last 12 months, or b) **arrange a visit from your vet** to provide you with a Vet Attestation and VAN. The visit does not have to have been specifically to provide a VAN – it can be provided during vet visits carried out for other purposes, as long as the criteria at question 10 in the Defra Q&A are covered which can be found at https://ahdb.org.uk/exports.

Familiarise yourself with changes that have been made to forms, systems and processes and include your VAN. This includes updated **LIS-Movement forms** (Sheep, Goats and Deer), and new functionalities within the **LIS** (Sheep, England), **eAML2** (Pig, England & Wales) and **Scot EID** (cattle, sheep and pigs, Scotland) digital movement systems.

Ask your livestock markets and/or abattoir where and how you can provide your VAN to them.

Read the Vet Attestation information here - https://ahdb.org.uk/exports DO NOT DO NOTHING.

If you do not act on this, your animal products will, very shortly, not be able to be exported to the EU.

During the implementation period, farmer self-declarations are still being accepted. However, the implementation period will end on the 12th of April 2024 and from 13th April 2024, if there is no VAN or other evidence that a farm visit has been carried out (Farm Assurance), animal carcasses, or parts of the animal carcass, will not be eligible for export to the EU

A different entry of clean cattle than has been seen so far this year, with a general lack of real top-end premium quality bullocks on offer leading to a slight easing of prices. Nevertheless, a storming 647kg Limousin steer from Mr W J P Julian of Summercourt was way out in front at 299p/kg to claim top honours for the day away to R J Trevarthen Ltd of Roskrow. Next up was a solid run of quality cattle from Messrs R H & C D Care of St Buryan, Penzance, with the pick of their Limousin steers to 287p/kg, which was tied with Limousin steer from Mrs J Julian of Summercourt at the same money. A good 630kg Limousin steer from Messrs J & J Sawle & Son of St Agnes was next to feature which realised 280p/kg to Mr R H Eddy of Tehidy, followed by an Angus steer from Messrs Care at 258p/kg bought by Harvey Brothers of St Just. Heifers to a top of 289p/kg for a cracking 665kg Limousin from Messrs W S Gay & Son of St Allen, Truro with a South Devon heifer from the same Vendor close behind at 282p/kg which were both bought by R J Trevarthen Ltd. Messrs Sawle were in the mix again with their Limousin heifer realising 279p/kg and a South Devon heifer from Mr T Eustice of Crantock, Newquay sold for 269p/kg, which was tied with an Angus heifer from Messrs Care.
