Numbers slightly increased on last week, but more clean cattle are still required to satisfy the strong and regular buyer demand. A tidy entry on offer with a lot of good heavy bullocks forward seeing the resultant pence-per-kilo averages ease slightly, but pounds-per-head values and trade still holding very strong. Top of the day was a classy 643kg Continental heifer from Messrs W H & L M Williams & Son of Allet, Truro at **306p/kg (£1,968)**, which was followed by an OTM Blue steer from Mr R Badcock of Constantine, Falmouth which topped the steers at **275p/kg**, with a **760kg** Continental steer from Messrs Williams hot on the heels at **269p/kg (£2,044)**. Next was a **679kg** Blue steer from Messrs A D & J A Bray of St Martin, Helston which realised **268p/kg** thereafter. A good **601kg** Angus steer from Mr N Withers of Kea, Truro parted away for **266p/kg** and Messrs Bray then marketed a further **677kg** Blue steer at **262p/kg**.

Another moderate entry of 41 cull cows this week, with farmers really kicking out numbers ahead of the looming winter months, resulting in a total of **268** cows through the Truro Cull Ring in the month of October. Top price was awarded to a South Devon cow from Mr A L Pascoe of Fraddam, Hayle at **236p/kg**, followed by a Limousin cow from Mr R I P Andrew of Coverack, Helston at **202p/kg** and a Limousin cow from Messrs R, H T & R M Rowe of Hayle realised **199p/kg**. A 999kg Shorthorn steer from Mr C J Roberts of Hayle sold for **195p/kg (£1949)** and a Hereford steer from Messrs M C D Ansell & Sons of Zennor was one bid behind at **194p/kg**. 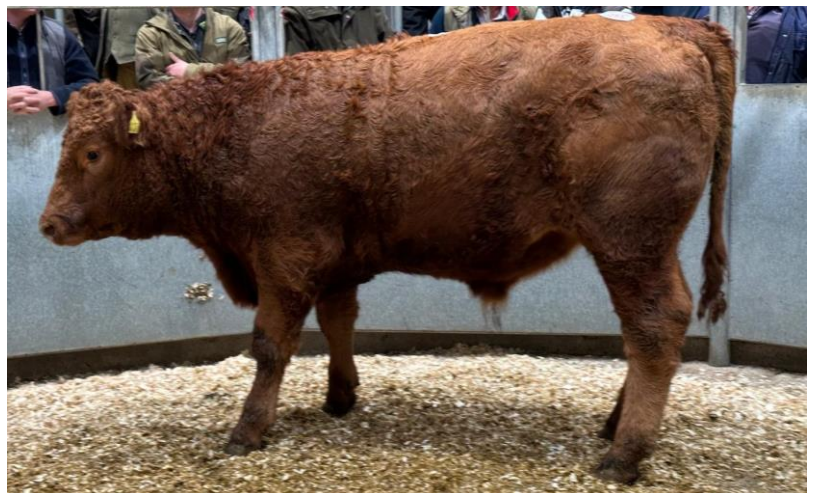
