Less numbers around in the cull section, although a good trade witnessed for those on offer. 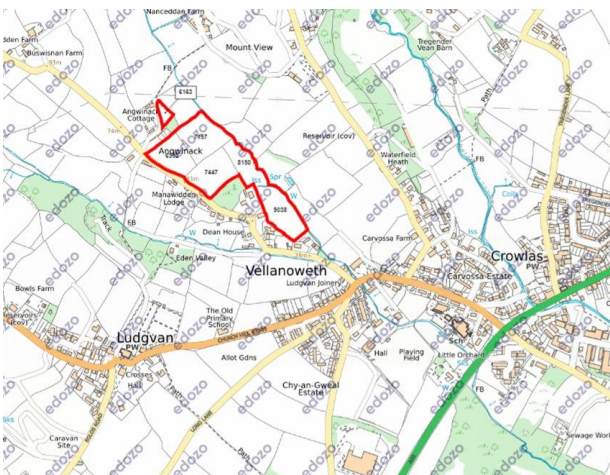

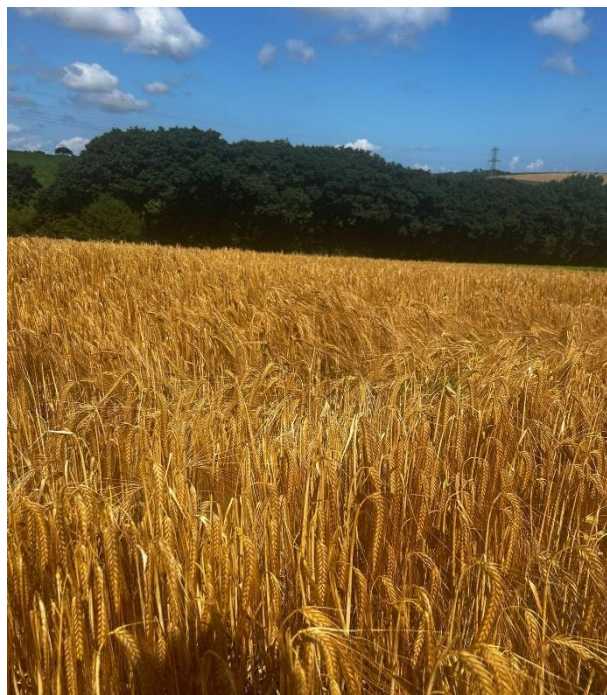
