These caravans may be suitable for storage or alternative uses, subject to obtaining the necessary permissions. The land is well enclosed, offering a high degree of privacy, and features a gentle slope.

Access is granted via a right of way over a short section of neighbouring land, with easy entry from the road. A gate provides direct access onto the property, and the track is wide enough to accommodate vehicles.

A historic mineshaft is recorded on the site, and any use or development of the land should take this into consideration for safety and planning purposes.
















Location

Nearby Porthleven is a growing culinary destination, while Prussia Cove and Helston have notable local history. St Erth station is approximately five miles away and provides direct rail connections to London, including an overnight sleeper train.

Directions

From the A30 heading into Hayle, take the 4th exit at Loggans Moor Roundabout onto Carwin Rise (B3301). At the next roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Guildford Road and continue for approximately 2.4 miles, following signs for Townshend. Drive through Townshend village, then turn left onto Bunkers Hill. Continue for about 1.4 miles towards Trescowe. Turn right into Millpool, then take the immediate left at the junction. Shortly after, the access to the yard will be on the left. The land is located on the left side of the properties, approximately 100 metres down the grass lane where you'll find the field gate.
