A sensational finished cattle trade seen at Truro, with the top prices sitting well above other South West markets. A premium pair of heavyweight Limousin steers from Mr M A Grigg of Lower Sticker, St Austell flew away to a top of **415p/kg** and **404p/kg**, with these also claiming the top spots for pounds-per-head at **£3,159** and **£3,030!** Cracking Herefords from Mr J M Venning of St Stephen, St Austell topped the heifer section at **382p/kg (£2,575)**, **378p/kg (£2,700)** and **376p/kg (£2,557)** and Mr C Keam of Luxulyan, Bodmin marketed his smart Limousin heifer at **370p/kg (£2,749)**. 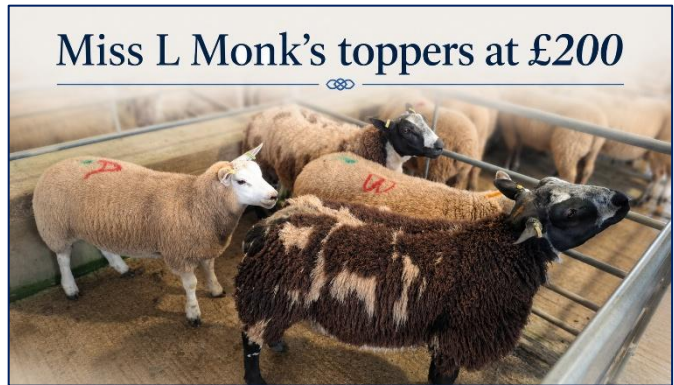
