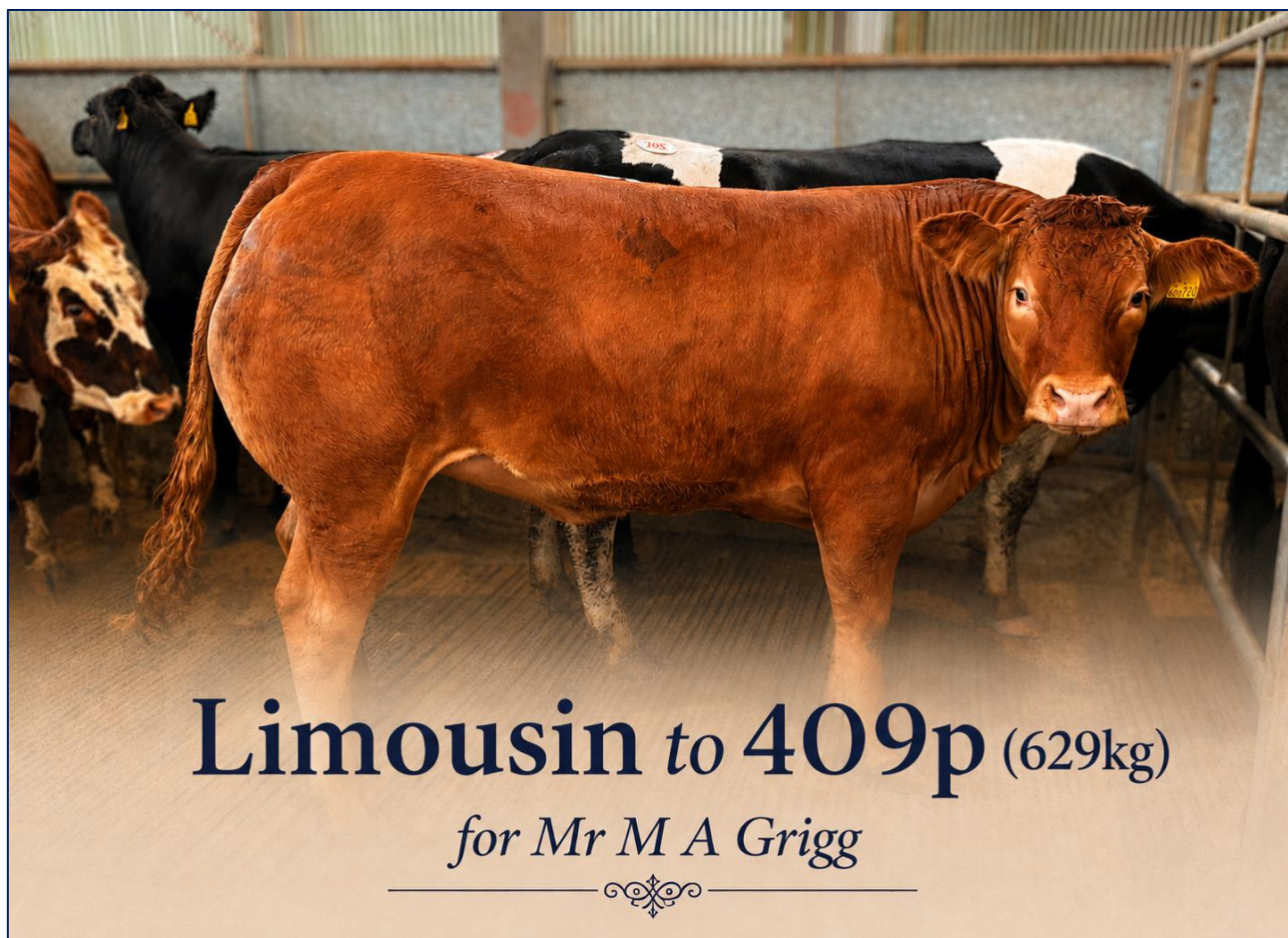

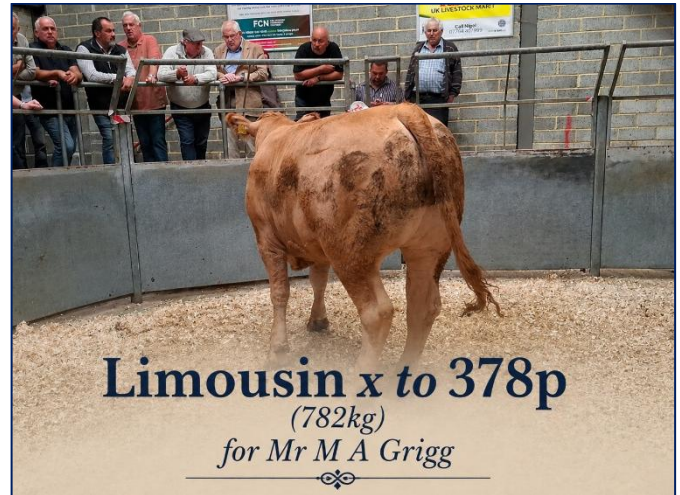
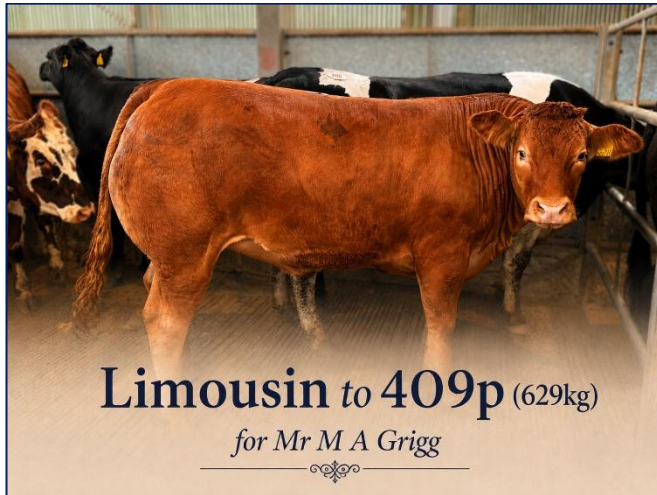
One of the largest entries of prime cattle for a long time through the ring this week contained a good proportion of wonderful quality cattle presented by vendors from throughout mid and west Cornwall. Breaking the **£4** per kg barrier again was an absolutely superb quality Limousin heifer from Mr M A Grigg of Lower Sticker who also achieved top value for one of his weighty Limousin steers at **£2956**. Other good steers from Messrs W S Gay & Son of St Allen, Messrs F T & F W Johns of Cury and Messrs R M Farming & Co of Sticker all meeting strong competition. A consignment of shapely non-FABBL Limousin heifers from Messrs A J & S T Richards of Rosenithon topped at **393p/kg** with trade for the quality sorts from Messrs J M Venning of St Stephen, Messrs V C & W G M Cock of Newbridge and Mr C Keam of Luxulyan showing good returns.

Good numbers forward and a high proportion of strong, forward types consigned met a firm trade. A 2yo Limousin from Messrs A T & S E Dunn of Helston realised **£2090**, a trio of Angus steers from Messrs W W James & Sons of Sancreed, Penzance sold to **£2005**, whilst Messrs L W & S Hosken of St Keverne, Helston sold a fine 17mo Simmental to **£1970**. Another big show of calves with over 100 passing through the ring, all seeing spirited bidding, resulting in a strong trade from start to finish. Top call of the day was **£810** each given for 3 British Blue x steers at 8 to 11 weeks old from Messrs W P & J Jenkin Ltd of St Martin, Helston who went on to sell another pair of British Blue x steers, 8 weeks old, for **£790** and a further pair at **£780**, with a much older 8 month old British Blue x steer flying away to **£1090**. The younger bull calves saw a British Blue x bull sell for **£570** for Messrs R, N W G & P J Worden of Gunwalloe, Helston closely followed by another British Blue x bull at **£555** for Messrs P J & O J Harvey of Coombe, Truro. Messrs J A Sweet & Partners of St Newlyn East, Newquay sold a British Blue x bull for **£505**. Best of the Aberdeen Angus x bulls making **£475** twice, firstly for Messrs P J & O J Harvey and then for Mr W R Davey of Probus, Truro who went on to sell Aberdeen Angus x heifers for **£395** and **£355**. A superb run of young Hereford x calves from Messrs R M & C D Rundle of Mevagissey, St Austell saw a fast trade with their best bulls at **£470** and **£455**, with the best heifer to **£400** and further heifers at **£380**, **£370** and **£365**. 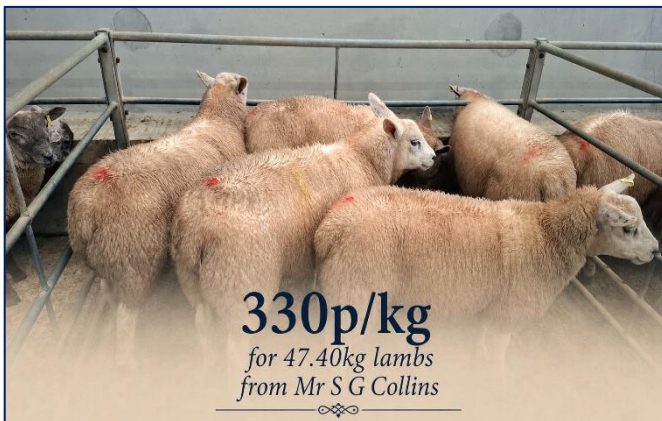
