A stand on trade to past weeks, although fewer real top-end premium sorts on offer. Nevertheless, Mr M A Grigg of Lower Sticker, St Austell back with another quality Limousin steer at **388p/kg (£2,856)**, followed by a smart 750kg Limousin heifer from Mr R H Eddy of Tehidy, Camborne at **386p/kg** and top pounds-per-head of **£2,895**. A Limo heifer from Mr Grigg away at **375p/kg (£2,573)** which was tied with a Limousin heifer from Mr W J P Julian of Summercourt, Newquay at the same money. A run of the usual quality cattle from J B Old Farms down from Treyarnon Bay, Padstow looked well sold with prices at **365p/kg (£2,533)** and **345p/kg twice (£2,294 & £2,401)** to name just a few.
